The <u>academic challenges</u> relate to <u>wrong and misguided preparation</u> related to the **evolving demand of the paper on content side and overall planning** as per your level of preparation.

The **<u>non-academic challenges</u>**, **<u>mostly overlooked and ignored</u>**, sometimes end up <u>becoming the major roadblocks</u> which create hurdles in a student's overall journey, which either a student doesn't identify or he fails to address them even after identifying because of no clear pathway.

## DETAILS OF VARIOUS PROGRAMS

#### 1) NCERT Classes

#### <u>Reading NCERTs is important, but usually most aspirants make many mistakes while</u> <u>reading them</u>

- Either completely ignoring them, or goes 100% into it. Both of these are wrong strategies.
- ✓ Focus merely on extracting factual information, rather than both conceptual and factual.

It is with this vision an **NCERT Course has been included for you**, with the following **objectives** 

- ✓ Clarity and Mastery of important Concepts and Themes
- ✓ Factual coverage this has become very important again in recent times
- ✓ Many Questions in UPSC prelims and Mains recently could be directly traced to NCERT, especially in 2023.

## 2) **Previous Year Questions Analysis**

Previous Year Questions are the **backbone and the soul** of any competitive examination. And for UPSC, it has emerged as even more important, be it Prelims or Mains. PYQ is the **biggest misutlised shield and sword** in the UPSC preparation.

#### The Previous Year analysis for 2024 Prelims will deal with

- a. PYQ Complete Analysis from 1995-2023.
  - i. Yes we are very clear on this. PYQs need to be analysed from 1995 to 2023. Not only from 2013 or the last few years.
  - **ii.** Very often it's the game of few marks and it would be an ocean of guilt if we miss out on something which UPSC had already asked.

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#### b. Detailed Analysis of 2023 Prelims, to :

- i. Tell you how UPSC has remained the same.
- ii. Tell you how UPSC has changed
- iii. Tell you how to perform, even in this atmosphere of chaos and complexity.
- c. Important Themes, Sub-Themes and topics which UPSC has always focused
- d. Logical skills to solve questions and how that thing has changed over years.
- e. Exploring the options other than the one which was the answer.

#### 3) Thematic Current Affairs

- **a. Objective** provide you the most relevant One Stop Solution for Current Affairs, so that you use it to *work for you, rather than working against you.*
- **b.** Coverage based on **important themes** which UPSC keeps on exploring from **last 2 years important themes** based on the trend of UPSC in last 5 years, especially last 3 years.
- c. **Covering the gap existing with respect to current affairs**, where coverage of all small and big current affairs of last 1 year isn't the solution. In fact that is an inefficient strategy.
- Rather, a more refined and directed strategy is covering major affairs of last
   2 years in a thematic manner.
- 4) Prelims Test Series

#### Some of these mistakes committed by the students in a test series are :

- Solving tests beyond the capacity
  - Of Course, you should solve as many tests as possible, but this doesn't mean solving 150 tests without analysing the previous ones.
  - Ideally, you should solve minimum 30-35 tests. Only after you have analysed them, should you move on to the next tests

#### Not Solving Quality Tests

- Solving average or poor quality tests can only give you temporary satisfaction, and not results. Unfortunately, <u>most test series today in market</u> <u>aren't well aligned</u> with the changing needs and the demand of UPSC
- <u>At SOMP, our aim is very simple</u> to give absolute quality and relevance in all the tests.
- Not analysing the tests, and harping on scores rather than the learnings.
  - In Simple words it's a sin to not do that.
- Having an impractical schedule of solving tests, and procrastination.




