Prelims with time has become <u>one of the most difficult stages to clear</u> because of its very nature of being the **largest eliminating stage**. 2023 Prelims was no less different. In fact, it was even more brutal than the previous Prelims. With expanding horizons of syllabus, increased complexity and newer and tougher ways offraming the questions, it won't be wrong to interpret that this challenge will continue, and most likely increase in 2024 Prelims.

A careful analysis of the multiple aspects present <u>two fold challenges</u> which students have faced in clearing this stage – the **academic challenges** and the **non-academic challenges**.

The <u>academic challenges</u> relate to <u>wrong and misguided preparation</u> related to the **evolving demand of the paper on content side and overall planning** as per your level of preparation.

The <u>non-academic challenges</u>, <u>mostly overlooked and ignored</u>, sometimes end up <u>becoming the major roadblocks</u> which create hurdles in a student's overall journey, which either a student doesn't identify or he fails to address them even after identifying because of no clear pathway.

- a. A program of <u>30-45 days for effective and quick revision</u> of the static part of the syllabus.
- b. No Irrelevant and Extra Notes will be given for the topics which are already present in the reference books. You just have to read those topics from the sources you've followed till now. (Any specific notes, however if required, will be given)

Strategy:

i. 3 Days - Live Zoom Session.

- i. You will be **guided to study the topics effectively** in the limited time.
- ii. You'll be **given time there and then** in the session. You have to complete the reading/ revision of that particular topic in that time.
- iii. Major points, most important facts will be highlighted which students shouldn't miss.
- iv. Appropriate PYQs, logical techniques, value additions will also be discussed.
- v. Specific focus on difficult, complex, ignored and important topics
- c. **Rest 4 Days** You have to complete things at your own pace. Readings and Revisions of the remaining topics and Revisions of the topics discussed in the live class.
