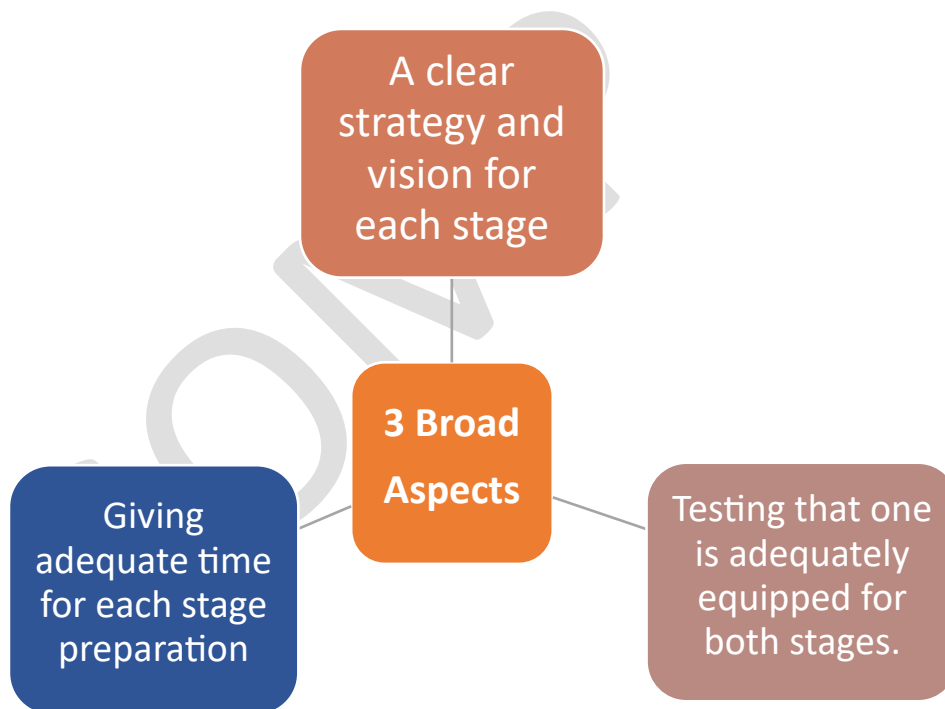


# Integrated UPSC CSE 2026 Mains-Cum-Prelims Program

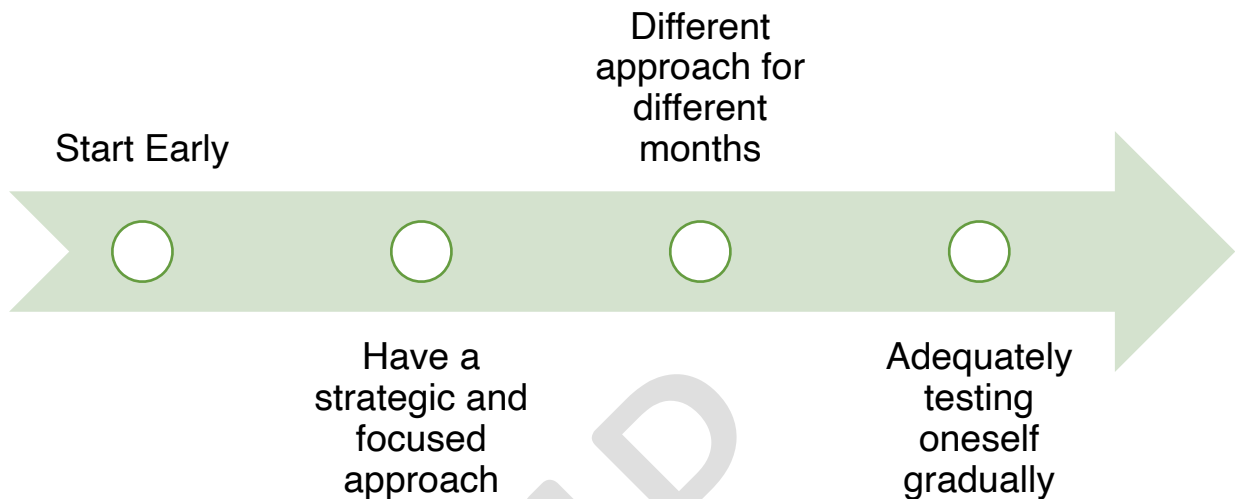
While there are aspirants who manage to clear it in just 1 attempt.

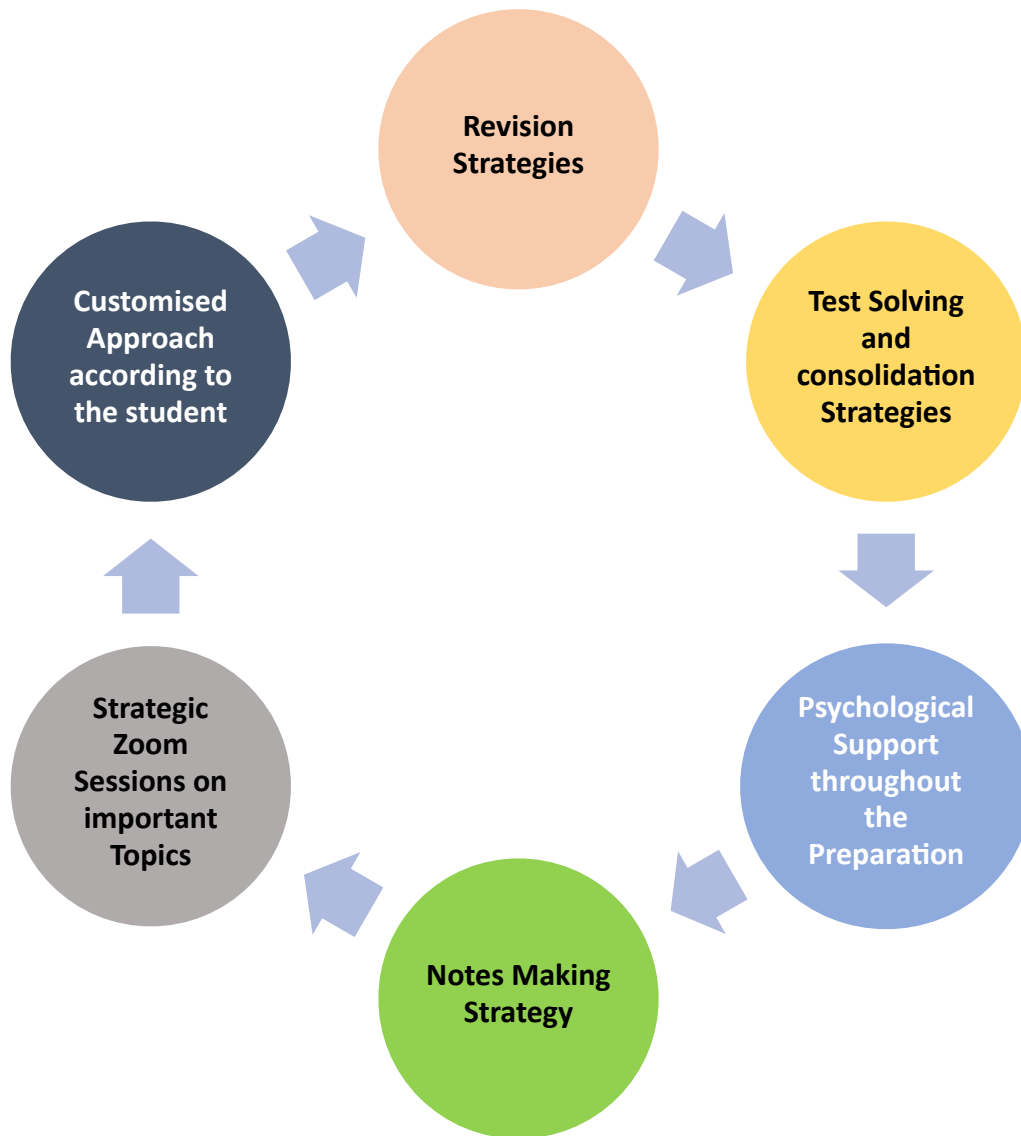
